Compulsory Courses

- ▶ All Year 12 students study 5 NCEA subjects
- ▶ All Year 12 students **MUST** study **English** and/or **Te Reo Maori**
- ▶ All Year 12 students are required to study **FOUR (4)** further **NCEA subjects**
- ▶ All Year 12 students will participate in a **recreation programme**

Six-Subject NCEA Programme

- ▶ This is an option for a limited number of students – principal's approval required
- ▶ All Six-Subject NCEA students **MUST** study **English** and/or **Te Reo Maori**
- ▶ All Six-Subject NCEA students are required to study **FIVE (5)** further **NCEA subjects**
- ▶ Six-Subject NCEA students **DO NOT** participate in a **recreation programme**
